


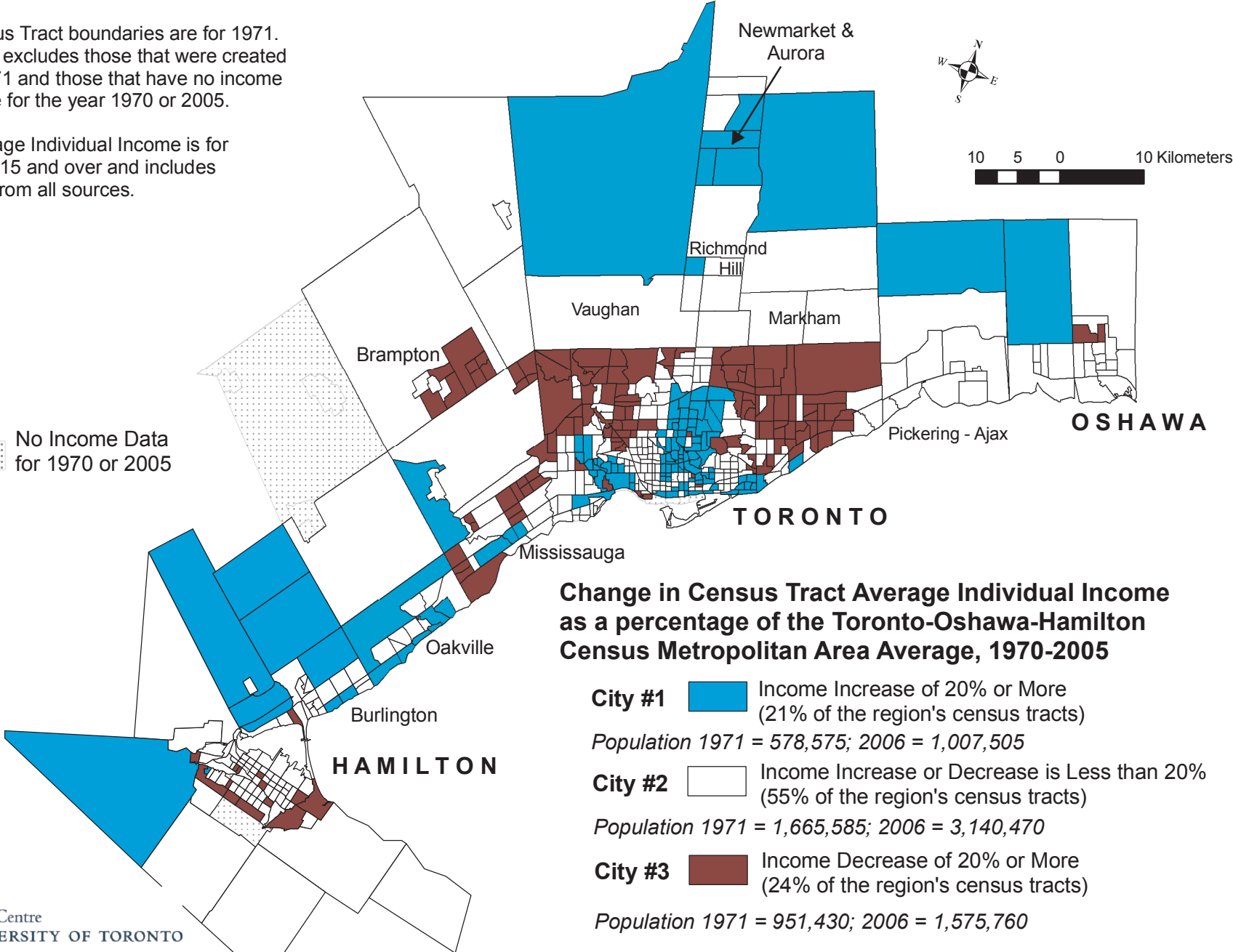
Change in Census Tract Average Individual Income, 1970-2005

Change in Census Tract Average Individual Income as a percentage of the Toronto-Oshawa-Hamilton Census Metropolitan Area Average, 1970-2005

- City #1**  Income Increase of 20% or More (21% of the region's census tracts)
 Population 1971 = 578,575; 2006 = 1,007,505
- City #2**  Income Increase or Decrease is Less than 20% (55% of the region's census tracts)
 Population 1971 = 1,665,585; 2006 = 3,140,470
- City #3**  Income Decrease of 20% or More (24% of the region's census tracts)
 Population 1971 = 951,430; 2006 = 1,575,760
