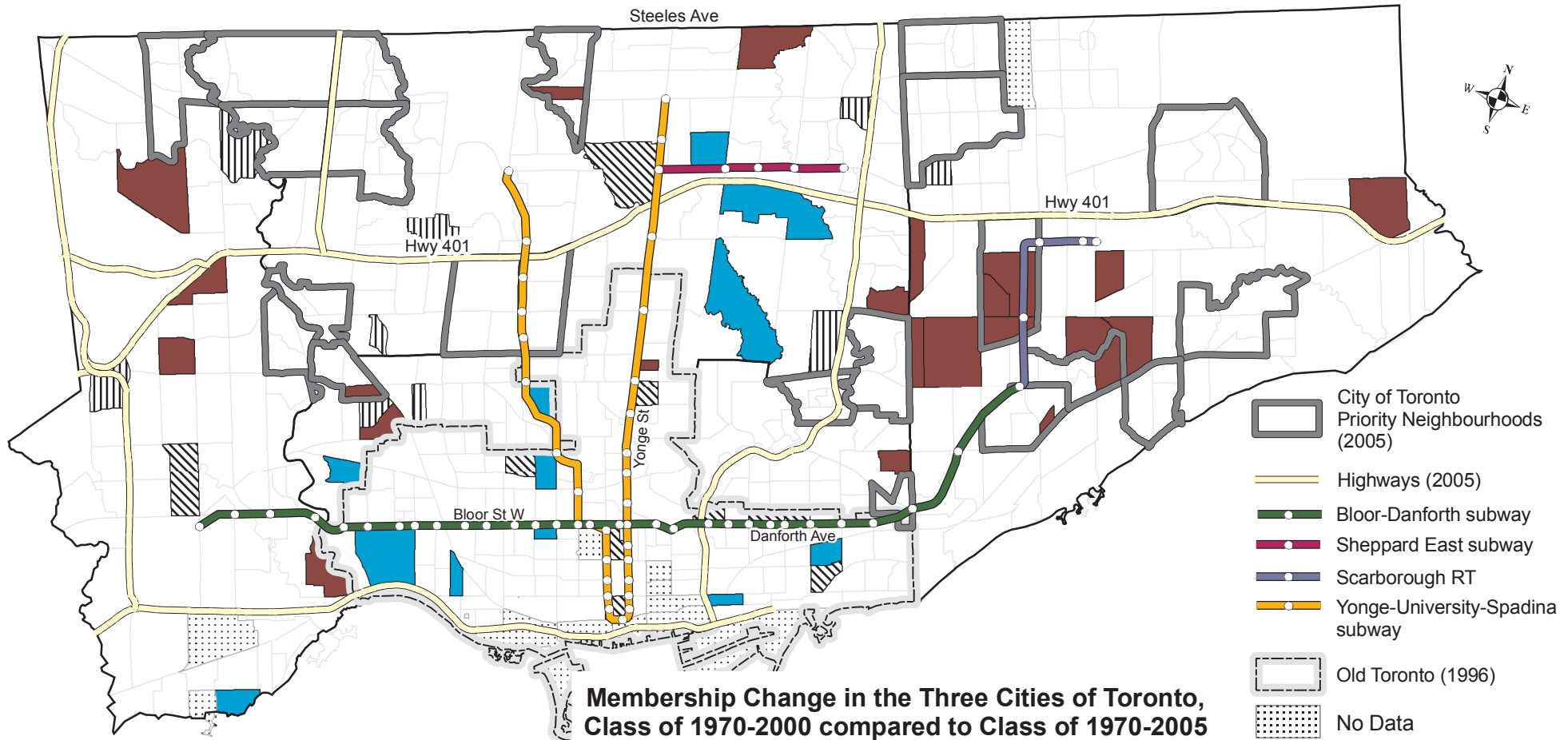


Neighbourhoods that Changed on the Three Cities Map of Toronto 2001 to 2006
