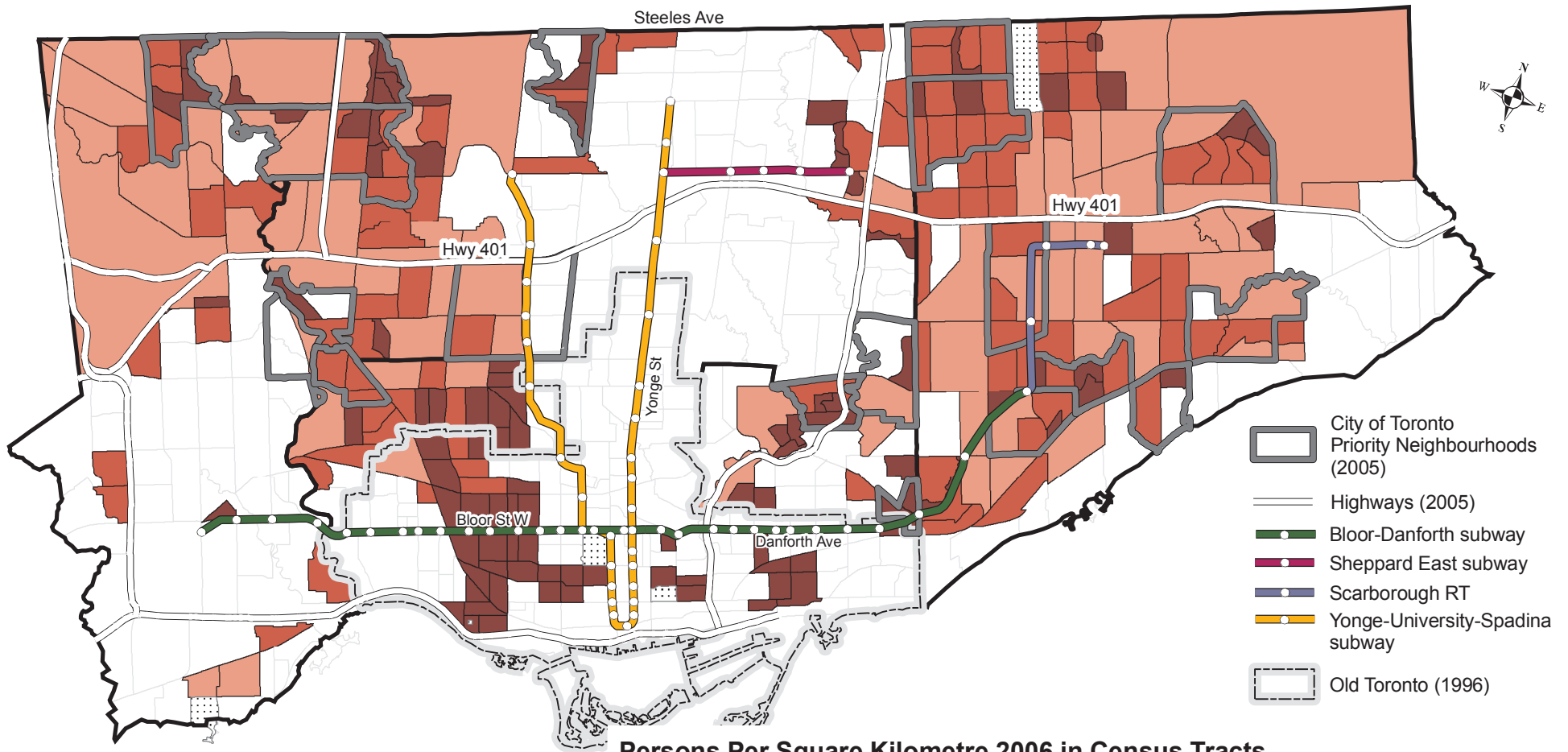







# Population Density of Low Income Neighbourhoods City of Toronto, 2006
